**New Windows for St Peter the Apostle:** We are delighted to let you know that over the coming weeks, St Peter the Apostle will be receiving replacement windows to the Tower, the Baptistry and the North and South Transepts, along with some local repairs to Tower brickwork. This has been made possible by a very generous grant from Historic England and the Department of Culture, Media and Sport. We are very grateful for the ability to undertake this work which has been needed for some time. The Works team will be using scaffold inside and outside the church and we are asking for your tolerance as the church will remain **closed for weekday masses which started from Tuesday 9th March but will be glad to open for the celebration of mass on Sundays** during the Works period which will be going on until June. As the car park will be used for the contractors' scaffolding and access, it will need to remain closed for the duration of the works.
