**Faithful Stewards of God’s Gifts-Time, Talents and Treasurer:** This new initiative within our Diocese seeks to help parishioners to see that they are very much responsible for their parish. **New Windows for St Peter the Apostle** The work on the replacement of St Peter the Apostle Church Tower, Baptistry and the North and South Transepts windows, along with some local repairs to Tower brickwork are still going on. The Works team is using scaffold inside and outside the church and we ask for your tolerance as the church will remain **closed for weekday masses but will be glad to open for the celebration of mass on Sundays** during the Works period which will be going on until June. As the car park is being used for the contractors’ scaffolding and access, it will remain closed for the duration of the works.

**First Holy Communion** The next class will be on **Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> June** for St Mary’s and Peter’s will be on **Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> June at 17:00** for both parishes. St Mary’s Classes will be in St Mary’s Church while St. Peter’s Parish does theirs in the parish Hall with both parishes observing the full COVID-19 rules.
