We pray for Fr Sam Leeder & Aniamma Sebastian (Anna) who died recently. May God rest them eternally and comfort their families. Fr Sam was a truly dedicated pastoral priest who served the parish of St Pancras in Ipswich for over forty years and Anna the mother of Thomas Sebastian - one of our parishioners in St Peter's.

As the year of St Joseph and The Family ends 26 June this year, the Icon of St Joseph blessed at the Mass of 19 March 2021 at the Cathedral (to mark the year of St Joseph and The Family) and which began its journey around the parishes of our Diocese, has reached St Peter's parish.
