Maintain, complete and submit Parish Financial Reports (PFR) to the Diocese Produce reports to the PPC, Finance Committee and AGM Monitor and reconcile the bank account regularly Produce annual budget Monitor Diocesan accounts (RCDEA issue a statement twice a year) Sign invoices and confirmations for all payments (can be done retrospectively rather than every time a payment is made) Take cash to the bank (can be done by any trusted volunteer) Ensure stock is maintained of cash bags and money bags (can be done by any trusted volunteer) Collect money (when required) and empty votive candle stands on a regular basis. We are also in need of a PARISH gift-aid officer
